

College of Letters and Science 2010 Commencement Ceremony

5 pm, Friday, June 11, 2010 Elvin Drake Stadium / Frank Marshall Field

GUEST INFORMATION

- 1. Please review in advance the separate information sheets for the tentative schedule for Friday, June 11, the site diagram, and the parking maps (General Parking and DP Permit Parking) that accompanied the Information Update posted on MyUCLA for the College of Letters and Science students participating in the 2010 Commencement Weekend.
- 2. The North and South Upper Concourse entry gates at Drake Stadium will be opened not later than 4:00pm (see the site diagram). If you park in Structure 7, consider exiting by the north stairwells/elevators on Charles Young Drive North and using the North Upper Concourse entry gates to Drake Stadium, rather than the south stairwells leading to Bruin Walk.
- 3. Each of the guest tickets for 2010 College Commencement has been printed with a unique bar code. Tickets will be scanned at the entry gate so that anyone with a counterfeit or duplicated ticket will not be admitted. Each guest must have a valid 2010 UCLA College Commencement BLUE ticket.
- 4. All guests must use the Upper Concourse gates except for those in wheelchairs, who are asked to come to the Field Level entrance at Bruin Walk (see the site diagram). Access to the general seating areas will be only from the upper concourse.
- 5. An attendant for an individual in a wheelchair coming to the Field Level entrance will not be required to have a guest ticket for entry, but the guest in a wheelchair is required to have a ticket.
- 6. All of the general guest seating at Drake Stadium are metal bleachers, with backs. While there are numbered seats on the bleachers, seating for the College Commencement is general admission, first-come, first-seated.
- 7. <u>Please do not use two seats for one person</u>. Nearly 9,000 guest tickets have been distributed!
- 8. There is no organized recessional at the end of the ceremony. At the conclusion of the ceremony, guests are invited to join the graduates on Marshall Field. Or, arrange in advance with your student graduate a preferred meeting location elsewhere on campus.
- 9. WEAR FLAT SHOES. Walking down/up the steps of Drake Stadium or walking on the grass fields after the ceremony with shoes that have elevated heels could lead to a twisted ankle!
